The White Bird first flew in the fall of 2021. During the 2022 flying season, the aircraft was tested for high-speed taxi (acceleration and braking performance), runway hops (takeoff and landing performance and optimal pilot settings), and it finally left the runway to perform

local pattern flights. The 2023 flying season was a busy one: the Dayton Airshow, parade and car show flyovers, cross-country flight to Batavia Ohio, and flights to Wright-Patterson Air Force Base and the historical Huffman Prairie, where the Wright Brothers learned to fly. The wings of our new aircraft were built to our specifications by the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) Chapter 5 of Middlefield, Ohio. In addition, numerous businesses have been generous enough to provide donated or reduced-price services, supplies, or parts to help with the completion of our aircraft.


