The new Wright "B" Flyer has been in design and construction for the past 4 years. A dedicated group of experienced WBF volunteers have completed the build of most all the major components of the aircraft including the tubular steel structures, wooden ribs and fabric covering. The wing structures were built to our design by the enthusiastic members of the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) Chapter 5 of Middlefield, OH. Numerous local businesses have been generous enough to provide some donated services



or reduced prices to help with the manufacturing of parts.

The biplane wing, center section structure, tail boom, stabilizer, rudder, ailerons, pilot platform, and landing gear are all completed. The avionics and electrical systems have been built and are installed. The brand new Lycoming IO-390 engine has been run and broken in and is also ready to be installed.

New WB-X Status

Tasks in progress remaining to be completed include installation of the fuel tanks, fuel lines, brake hydraulic lines, flight control linkages and pilot seats. After the final assembly and checkout, ground tests will be conducted including: thrust runs, control surface checks, weight and balance measurements, and test instrumentation checks.

Now, our biggest challenges are completing details and staying on schedule for final assembly in January.

"Valentine Flyer" — a Near Replica of the Wright "B" Flyer — Displayed at San Antonio's 300th Anniversary

Fort Sam Houston MILITARY APPRECIATION DAY May 2018.


Wright "B" Flyer, INC sent the "Valentine Flyer," a full-scale, near-replica of the Wright Model B Flyer, named for its builder, to the Army's Fort Sam Houston post in San Antonio, TX. Wright "B" Flyer volunteers Bill Jamison, Jim La Salvia, Linda Madaffer, Nick Statzer and Jerry Troidl assembled and displayed the flyer on the historic post's parade field for three days. Thousands viewed the flyer, which was positioned next to an F-16, and was a great example of the progression of the first military plane to current flight. This was the Wright "B" Flyer's second excursion to San Antonio. The first display was March 2010. It was the 100th anniversary of the first solo military flight made by Army Lt. (later Maj. Gen.) Benjamin Foulois. March 2, 1910, Foulois taught himself to fly at Fort Sam Houston by corresponding frequently with the Wright Brothers. The Valentine aircraft will be stored in a container for the winter at the Dayton-Wright Brothers Airport.
